PROJECT SUMMARY

PAS managed and neutrally facilitated a series of conversations and workshops to bring people together to discuss and share ideas for the future to create a local place plan for Elie & Earlsferry called 'Going Forth'. Ideas and prioritised actions were illustrated and actioned over the short/medium/long term to signpost gradual change.

WHY WE DID IT

To better understand the current and future planning and place needs of the whole Elie and Earlsferry community by bringing together local people, Fife Council, local landowners, businesses, local schools, care homes, and community groups. To create a platform for the community to voice their own aspirations, to guide their own future change, and to promote/enhance social cohesion.

- Aligning spatial and community planning in accordance with the Place Principle.
- An Action Plan of priority projects, together with a vision and strategy to guide gradual change.
- Community ownership of the process and progress in moving forward with both short and longer-term priority projects.
